✓ be a Registered Member of Ngāti Paoa Iwi Trust.




- be 18 years of age or over.
- get three (3) people to support your nomination, who are 18 years of age or older, and are also of shown as a Registered Member on the Ngāti Paoa Members' Register. You will need to get these people to put their full name, residential address and signature on Section B of the nomination paper.

YOU MUST NOT:

- be or have ever been convicted of an offence involving dishonesty as defined in section 2(1) of the Crimes Act 1961, or an offence under section 373(4) of the Companies Act 1993 (unless you are eligible for the purposes of the Criminal Records (Clean Slate) Act 2004);
- V be bankrupt or have made any composition arrangements with creditors;
- have been convicted of an indicatable offence (unless you are eligible for the purposes of the Criminal Records (Clean Slate) Act 2004); or
- be subject to a compulsory order under the Mental Health (Compulsory Treatment and Assessment) Act 1992 or be subject to a care and protection order under the Protection of Personal and Property Rights Act 1988;
- have, within the last three (3) years been removed from the office of Trustee in accordance with clause 21.3 of the Deed of Trust
